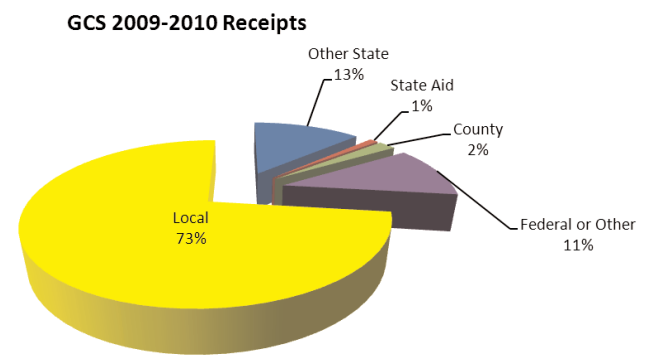
GARDEN COUNTY JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

The Nebraska Health and Human Services System has determined that due to the fact that the Garden County Junior High School public water well is less than 50 feet deep there is a potential risk of the direct influence of surface water. As a result of this determination, the Garden County Junior High School is taking the following precautions to assure an adequate supply of safe water on a continuous basis:

- The Garden County Junior High School public water supply system shall be operated and supervised by personnel with a certificate of competency issued by the Director of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure. The certified operator will be on call 24-hours a day, will conduct all required testing and will notify the Director of any situation that may present an imminent hazard to health.
 - An Emergency Plan will be in effect for safe-guarding the water supply, protecting the drinking water, and, if necessary, providing for an alternate drinking water supply in the event of a disaster.
 - There will be an on-going program for the effective detection and elimination of cross-connections and the prevention of backflow or backsiphonage of the water system. All backflow and backsiphonage protection devices equipped with test ports will be tested as often as required by the public water supply system by a backflow prevention test and repair technician certified by the Director. The Garden County Junior High School will access and report potential backflow hazards on the premises and take any steps necessary for protection of public health and safety as often as necessary.
- Detailed descriptions of the management plan are on file and open for inspection to all interested patrons. The Garden County Junior High School is required to notify all patrons of this management plan and the safety measures instituted.

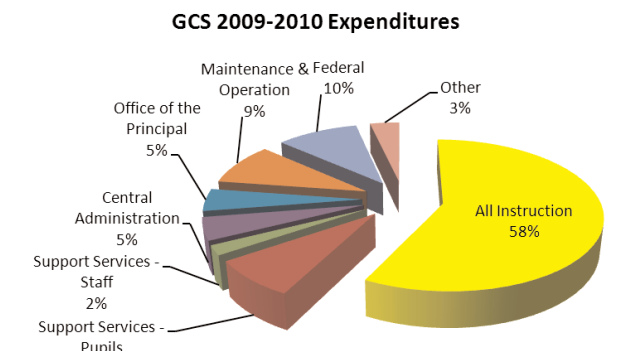
SCHOOL FUNDING Receipts
