The district uses things to help stop and clean the building for COVID. We use two prominent companies. EX: disinfection equipment such as hand sanitizer machines, disinfection guns for classrooms and gyms, UV ray machines, and supplies for minor cleaning. The district uses a school psychologist and other professionals with their content to help all students. The district had to purchase and hire more mental health professionals and materials to help out on our students and staff because of covid. We purchased online interventions that could be used to help catch up with students who fell behind due to covid. Technology tools and equipment for students and staff are needed to make these programs work properly. We brought in professionals from ESU 13 and other panhandle schools to help these students out due to covid. The school bought Air Quality control machines to help out with covid or any other disease these machines purify the air inside the building so we can keep in-person learning. We have them stationed in all areas of the building.
